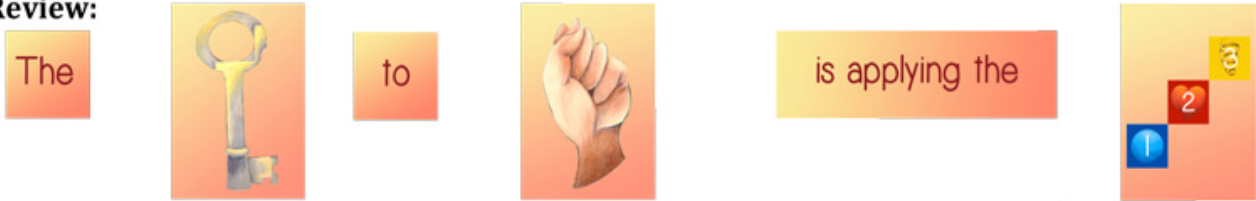

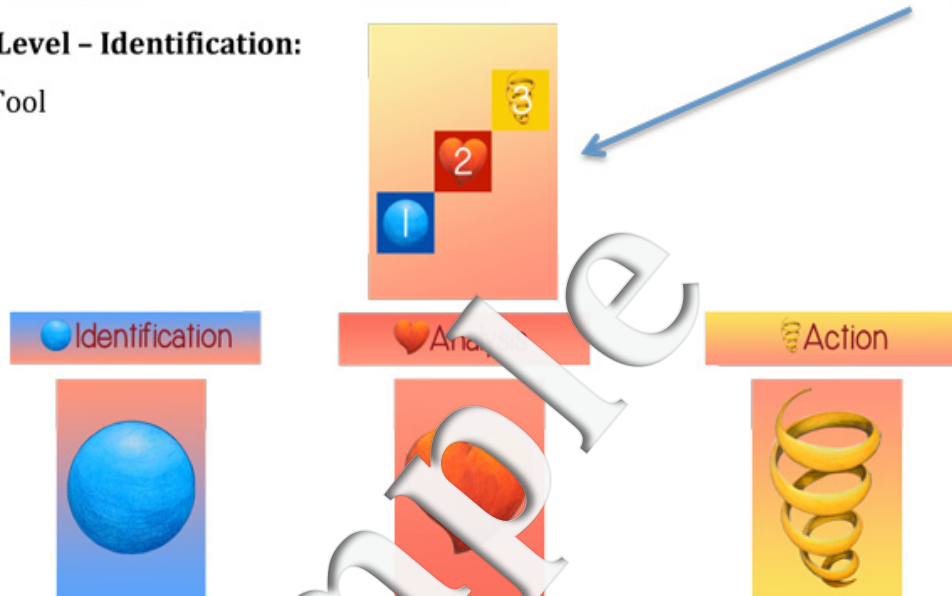

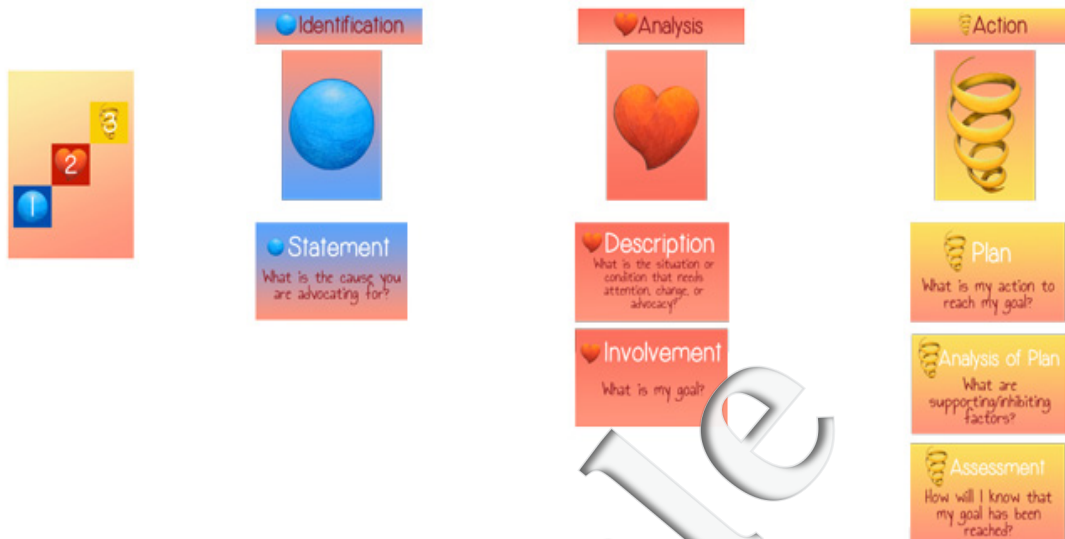

The 3-Step-Tool to Empowerment involves these actions (lay out the 2nd presentation cards).

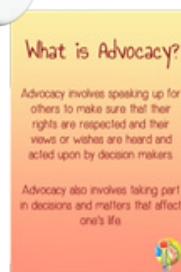


Introduce Advocacy: The application of the 3-step-tool is effective because it helps us advocate for something that is important to us. Lay out the following cards:

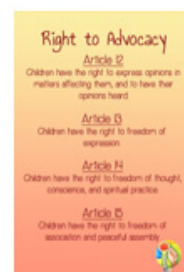
